Unbleached Cotton Tying Tape – Archival Quality

Used by the Worcestershire Archive and Archaeology Service for tying up bundles of documents and folders, as well as tying together damaged books while they await repair.

Available by the roll – $16mm \times 100m £10.60 + £2.12 VAT (£12.72)$

Smoke Sponges

Dry cleaning sponges are used by the Worcestershire Archive and Archaeology Service to remove dust, soot and dry mould from books and paper. These can also be used to remove surface dirt from wallpaper, painted metal and wood surfaces, and fabrics.

Archive Storage Boxes

Sturdy boxes constructed of acid free cardboard to allow easy storage of archival materials.

Bags for Rolled Maps

These are sewn from Tyvek, an inert non-woven polyethylene fabric-like material that is soft and flexible and ideal for making protective covers for museum, archive and library objects. Bags can be made to any size and offer a flexible storage solution for rolled maps and plans.

Sizes currently available are:

Small - for rolls up to 600mm in length £4.00 + £2.80 VAT (£4.80)

Medium – for rolls up to 850mm in length £5.00 + £1.00 VAT (£6.00)

Folders
